This class is designed for individuals who are developmentally and/or physically disabled and would like to learn how to ice skate. They will work with our professional staff that volunteer their time and are trained to meet your skater’s individual needs.

Some of our coaches are also staff ice skating coaches for Sports for Exceptional Athletes, a San Diego based sports program helping special needs people from ages 3 to adult.

The semester package includes:

- * **One 30-minute class** each week during the semester, skate rental is included.
- * **Unlimited** access to any of our available public sessions. Skate rental is included.
- * **One time discount** at Skate n Dine and Cutting Edge Sports.
- * **Discounts** are available for early registration, multiple classes taken in a semester, and multiple family members registering at the same time.
- * **Certificates** are given to students at the end of the semester for completing the class.
